- give you "the look"?
- shove, slap, or hit you?
- follow you, spy on you, or show up at your job, school or friends' homes?
- listen to your telephone calls?
- force you to have sex when you don't want to?
- accuse you of having affairs?
- control all the money or keep you from having little or none?
- tell you how sorry he/she is about hurting you, yet it happens again?

OUR SERVICES

All victims, male and female, of domestic and sexual abuse can find services at Women and Children's Horizons.

WE PROVIDE

- Emergency safety shelter
- 24 hour crisis line for support, information, advocacy, one-on-one peer counseling and referrals
- Support groups for victims of domestic and sexual abuse
- Parenting classes
- Children's programming and education groups
- Safe exchange for child visitations
- Transitional living program
- Food/clothing/donation pantries for those served by the agency
- Circle of change group for men and women who are controlling and abusive in relationships
- Education/Outreach for the community
- FIP- Family Intervention Program. Provides the link between families and community resources through home visits.

LEGAL ADVOCATE

The Advocate is able to provide victims with information about criminal cases, accompany them to court or meetings with the District Attorneys, or meet with them individually to listen and offer support.

LEGAL ADVOCATE

Family Court / Civil Cases...262.656.3500

The Advocate is able to provide victims with information and support through family court and civil cases. This includes divorces, legal separations and child custody issues. The Advocate is available to attend court hearings or meet with the victim individually to listen and offer support.

RESTRAINING ORDER ADVOCATE
